

07-2021 Ordinance to regulate stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles.

STATE OF WISCONSIN

Town of Woodville

Calumet County

The Town Board of the Town of Woodville, Calumet County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.13, Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the regulation of the stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles on town highways in the town as follows:


- A. The stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles on the following town highways in the Town of Woodville is subject to the following restrictions and limitations: no parking on the south side of Dundas Road from the intersection of Brant St. John Road to the east 720'.
- B. The town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs on the above-described highways on or before the effective date of this ordinance.
- C. No persons may operate any vehicle on the above-noted town highways in violation of the above-noted stopping, standing, or parking restrictions and limitations. Any violation shall be subject to a forfeiture of \$50.

This ordinance is effective on August 15, 2021.


The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
